Brother Arnold Named New Vice President

Election of Henry A. Page, Jr., as president of the Page Dairy Co. and his brother, Arnold H. Page, as vice president,

was announced today following the annual meeting of the company's shareholders and directors. They are sons of the late Henry Page, Sr., who founded the firm in 1913.



The brothers also were elected to the company's directorate

along with Roland Rogers, Karl M. McKee, Thomas H. Kiley and Benjamin B. Boals.

Henry A. Page, Jr., a 1937 engineering graduate of Cornell University, became general manager of Page Dairy in 1940, a post he has held since. His brother, also a Cornell engineering graduate and student of dairy technology, entered the company's employ in 1945 and has been serving as production manager.
